- Discussion on brick placement for pavilion. No action taken.
- Discussion about having a gun raffle to use towards the pavilion. That was approved. Ray will work with Frank to finalize. Tickets would be \$10.00 and we would sell 100 of them.
- Ray attended the District 7 meeting on August 2, 2025 in Conway. Ray reported on the following: The Legion College is in November for new officers; training for officers ongoing; make-a-wish commander's project; Post Vigil in September 2026 at the Loudon Post; The Fall Conference is at Tilton, Post 49 October 25, 2025 and The Mid-winter conference is at Rochester Post in January 2026.

Sgt at Arms Peavey collected \$8 for the Post.
